DO NOT FEED NĒNĒ

- *People food, bird seed and domestic chicken feed is unhealthy for nēnē.*
- *Attracting nēnē to humans puts them at risk of dangers like vehicle collisions and dog attacks.*
- *Feeding creates unnatural behaviors that reduces their ability to survive in the wild.*
- *Unnaturally large groups of nēnē can become aggressive towards one another.*
- *It's a crime: Nēnē are protected by State and Federal endangered species laws. It is a illegal to interfere with their natural behavior, which includes giving them food and water.*
